

After the packs were bagged, they were taken to the hospital in large boxes and was distributed to veterans who are at the VA Hospital for medical treatments and tests. "When veterans come to the hospital, they are often having tests that require them to have an empty stomach and they will wait on results," said Jennifer Wolcott, Tennessee Region Tiffany Circle Chair who hosted the project. "They are hungry after those tests. This is an easy way to help them and make a difference. Sometimes we also give these out to homeless veterans." The group makes the snack packs twice a year, and since they began the project in 2015, the ground has made and delivered more than 4,500

snack packs to veterans.




